PROBLEM

Children play sports less and less in the Netherlands

- ► Among young people between the ages of 6 and 18, only 75% play sports weekly.
- ▶ 1 in 6 youths are addicted to their smartphone, only training their thumb.
- Increasing inflation and energy costs are making it more difficult for families to afford sports club memberships and equipment purchases.

Increasing Polarisation

• Since the outbreak of the coronavirus, social unrest has become more visible both in public and on social media.

Ultimate Frisbee is barely available in the Netherlands

► There are only 8 cities in The Netherlands where Ultimate Frisbee is offered.

ULTIMATE FRISBEE



TEAM SPORT

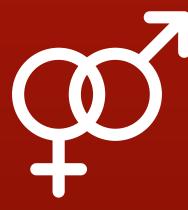
Ultimate Frisbee is a fast and dynamic non-contact team sport played with a frisbee. It requires athletic skills such as sprinting, jumping, diving and throwing, as well as precision and teamwork among players.



SELF-REGULATED

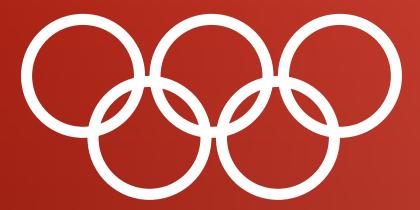
Ultimate Frisbee is self-regulated, meaning there are no referees and players are responsible for regulating a fair game themselves.

There is a strong emphasis on sportsmanship and fair play, known as the Spirit of the Game.



MIXED GENDER

Ultimate Frisbee promotes gender equality by allowing men and women to play together, even at the highest level. Playing a mixed sport teaches children that men and women are equal, as they see both genders playing together.



IOC RECOGNISED

Ultimate Frisbee is recognised as a sport by the International Olympic Committee (IOC). This means it is seen a full-fledged sport on an international level and has the chance to become an Olympic sport in the near future.

MISSION STATEMENT

Our mission and goal is to make Ultimate Frisbee available to all children in the Netherlands. Thanks to the unique characteristics of the sport, we want to help children grow into positive, vital, respectful and honest individuals who are able to interact in a controlled way even in stressful situations. We want to achieve this by offering high quality Ultimate Frisbee training in over 80 cities in the Netherlands with a passionate team of managers, region coordinators and trainers.

TARGET AUDIENCE

- Children between 6 and 18 years old

PROGRAM

Training

► We will organise weekly Ultimate Frisbee training for children.

Competition

For children from 7 till 12, we will start organising HAT tournament days, where children from all clubs regional clubs get shuffled in teams. They will play all sorts of games with the frisbee. For children from 12 till 18 we will setup a new youth competition for Dutch teams. During the season, youth clubs will compete in regional competitions and the top teams from each region will then compete on a final competition day.

Camps

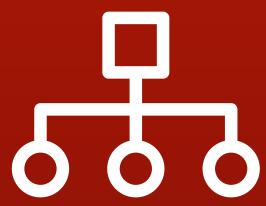
• We will organise Ultimate Frisbee camps for children during the spring, summer, and autumn holidays. Experienced players can learn more skills and new players can learn the basics. Every camp we will have a HAT tournament where we mix all skill levels.

SOCIAL ENTERPRISE

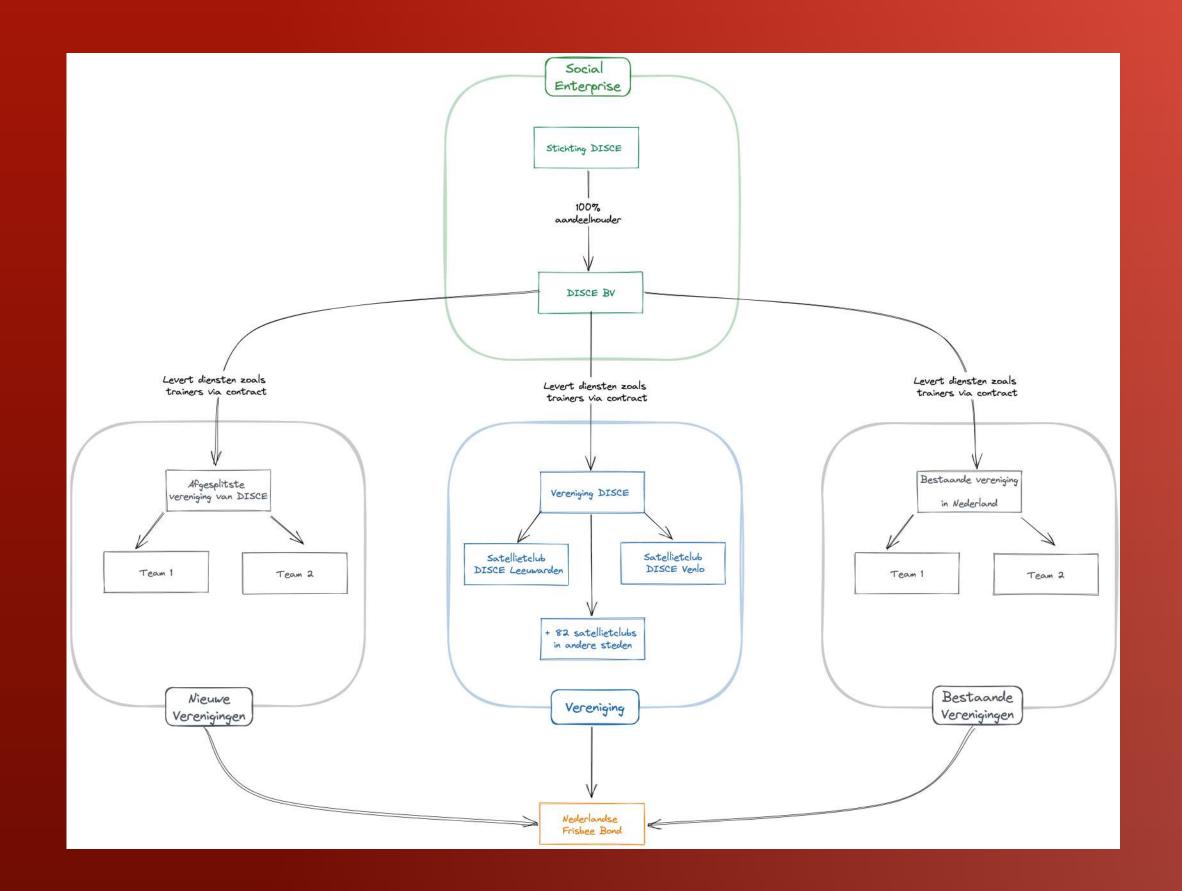
We want to become a Social Enterprise and uses the power of business to create positive social change in a sustainable and financially viable way. We pursue social impact and not profit maximisation.



STRUCTURE

We currently are a foundation.

In the near future we want to add a private company and an association. The private company will 100% be owned by the foundation. The association has will have many satellite clubs and makes use of the services of the private company.





ROLES

Managers

• The managers are responsible for the general business operations, finance, PR, HR, the program. They will manage the satellite clubs. We will start with one manager during the pilot fase.

Region coordinators

• Every region coordinator will coordinate 12 satellite clubs, will arrange fields and is the first contact point for the trainers. During our pilot year, the manager will manage the region.

Trainers

- ► Trainers work in duos and are jointly responsible for a fixed satellite club.
- Most have followed or are following a sports pedagogy education or are Ultimate Frisbee players themselves.

ITRAINER TRAINING

In-house trainer training program

• The program focuses on practical skills, pedagogical methods, and sport-specific knowledge, with the aim of producing professional and competent trainers who can effectively and safely deliver training sessions to our members.



Fostering Ultimate Frisbee and life skills

• Our training curriculum consists of exercises aimed at developing Ultimate Frisbee skills, teamwork skills, and the cognitive, social-emotional, and moral skills of the players. The program places emphasis on fun and teamwork.

Database en web application

We will work with a centralised database filled with exercises and games. In the near future our trainers can use a web application to create professional, inspiring, and enjoyable training sessions, as well as access ready-made training sessions to make the process even easier.

MARKET SUMMARY

400,000 potential new young athletes

• According to NOC*NSF statistics, around 825,000 Dutch children do not play sports on a weekly basis. Nearly half of them have the potential to start playing sports, according to this research.

No equal gender representation

• Research by various organisations, including the European Union and World Health Organisation, shows that women's participation in team sports is often less than 40%,

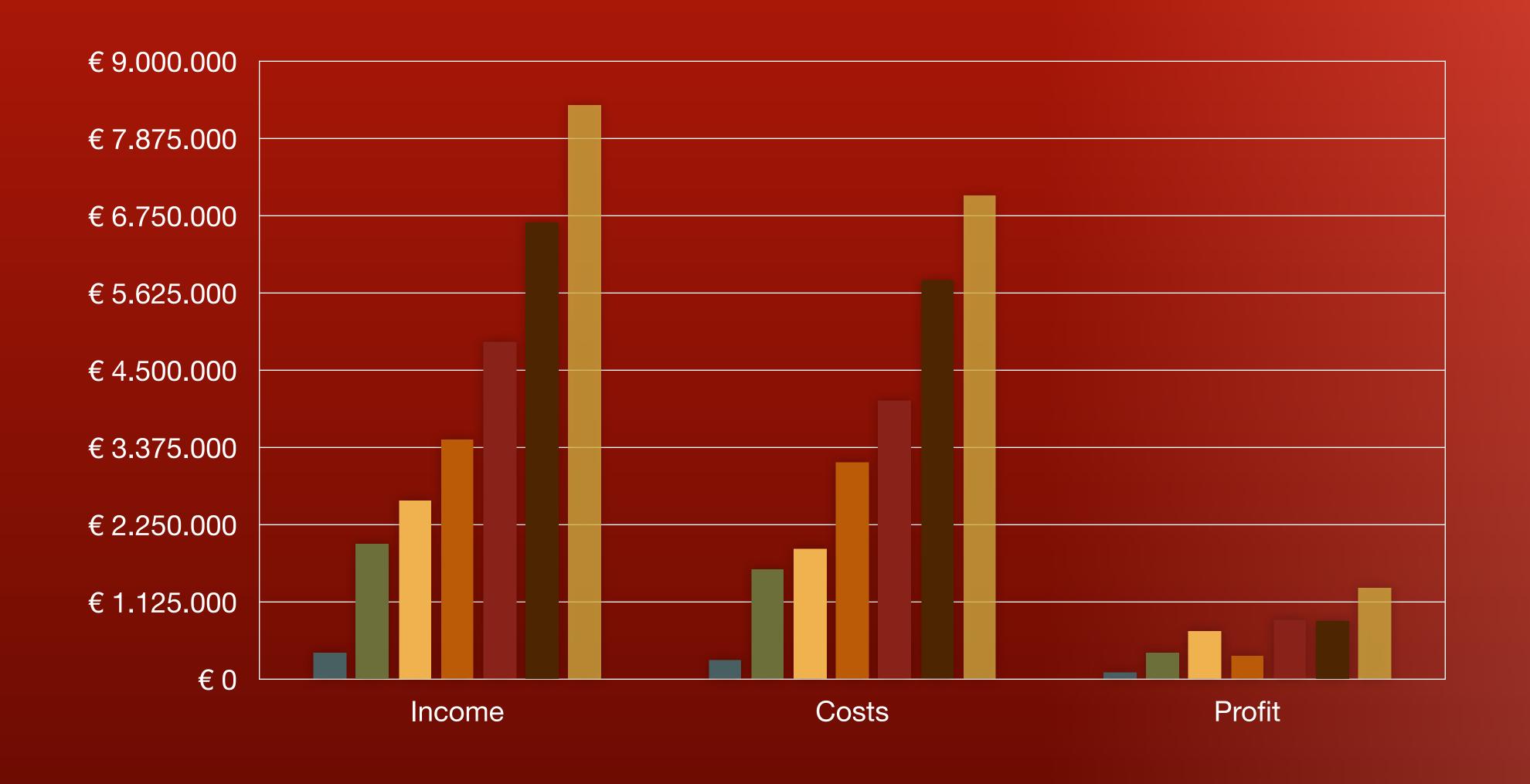
